#### **3. Scoring System/Results**

Thank you to Daniel for collating the results and for his work with Sam Weston on the website, it looks great! For next year, we'll look to also have results available as a csv file.

A lot of clubs were DSQ'd this year due to not having enough runners to count as a team. We agreed to keep the numbers as 4 to count for the men and 3 for the women but teams that are short will take the last number plus 1. If there are 200 racers then they would be awarded 201<sup>st</sup> place. Daniel to liaise with Sam to see if this is possible.

#### 4. Venue Review

All venues worked well this year. Badger Farm was the only event where it wasn't possible to have toilets. Council said no. For next year, we'll make sure we repeat the message to runners that they need to find alternatives. Maybe give park and ride toilet details so people can stop on the way.

Stoke Park Woods would make a good new venue but need to find parking. Also worth enquiring about a return to Fleming Park or Beaulieu Estate. Matterley Bowl drew a dead end due to their commercial interests. If we did secure another venue early enough then we could possibly replace one of the Itchen events.
